A.) Grade Level Realignment (See narrative below).

B.) First reading of proposed Extracurricular Activities Handbook (See attachment).

C.) First reading of proposed Cooperative Agreements – USD #269-Palco (See attachments).

A.) Beginning with the 2014-15 school year, USD 326 will realign grade levels using the following format:

- PreK - 4th Grade – Located in the South End of the Main Campus
- 5th - 8th Grade – Located in the East Building throughout the Morning, then will be located in various elective courses throughout the afternoon.
- 9th-12th Grade – Located in the North End of the Main Campus.

The following courses and/or time will be added as a result of instructor transfers:

- Comp I & II will now be available on campus
- New Social Sciences Elective
- Weights (additional section)
- General Chemistry
- Title I services will now be provided all day
- 7th and 8th grade computers will now offered for a full semester each
- 5th-8th Vocal Time was increased

At this time, there are not any existing courses or time that will be lost as a result of these transfers.

B.) After several months of work, the Coaches Committee has drafted the attached proposal for an Extracurricular Activities handbook. This is intended to be a first draft reading with final approval to be requested during the May Board of Education meeting.
