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Course Description:

This class will provide you with an introduction into all aspects of animal and food sciences. This class will introduce students to the world of animal agriculture and allow them to become more familiar with common terminology, physiology, practices and other aspects of many animal industries. This course studies the basic principles of animal agriculture including health, reproduction, genetics, nutrition, marketing, economics, meats, and systems productions.
